

**Druid City Bicycle Club
Officer's Meeting
March 1, 2010**

Present: Pixie Hicks, Larry Pierson, Laurie Bonnici, Bulldog Fisher, and Barry Lawrence

1. Barry reported that this will be the last year that the hospital will support the Hot Hundred ride. The DCH Foundation is not committing man power to support/organize the ride. Barry is willing to direct the ride this year as long as half of the proceeds go to Mental Health Association. Discussion ensued about cause to select related to the ride (was Mental Health). Pixie suggested Bicycle Advocacy. Laurie suggested the option of a registration fee and then a minimum fundraising amount to participate. *(Barry exited the meeting)* Larry clarified that he is not requesting compensation for the work he does for the ride.
Action: Pixie will talk to Pam about 501 C status impacts on contractual issues with paying ride director.
2. Bulldog reported that Walls News Media will no longer be hosting websites. We need to find a website host. Go Daddy costs approximately \$6 per month.
3. Safety issues were discussed in relation to group rides.
Action: Larry will draft a message for review and then post a message to the DCBC list, coinciding with the first 5 PM ride, about safety issues.
4. Laurie reported that membership is at 129 as of March 1, 2010. She suggested encouraging renewal for 2011 to use Sign Me Up so that we have an accurate database that is searchable. Also, this would make things easier at the annual holiday party to not have a crowd gathered at the door to sign up.
5. Bill Herz requested by e-mail to Pixie that we distribute a message to DCBC members asking them to comment on the proposed Alabama State Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan.
Action: Bill and Pixie will work together to compose a letter for e-mail to the Club encouraging them to respond positively to the Alabama State Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan
